ORDINARY TIME**

Isaiah 6:1-2a-3-8
Psalm 138
1 Corinthians 15:1-11
Luke 5:1-11

KEY VERSE: "Do not be afraid; from now on you will be catching men" (v 10).

READING: As Jesus preached on the shore of the Lake of Gennesaret (the Sea of Galilee), the crowds pressed in on him in such numbers that he was forced to get into a boat that belonged to Simon Peter. Jesus told Simon to put out into the deep waters and prepare for a great catch. Simon protested that they had fished all night and caught nothing, but on the authority of Jesus' word he obeyed. Upon seeing the miraculous draught of fish, Simon was overcome and he confessed his sinfulness. When the fishermen brought their boats ashore, they left everything behind and followed Jesus. This miraculous draught of fish signified the future mission of the Church. The disciples' efforts to bring souls to Christ would be successful if they obeyed him and remained true to his words.

REFLECTING: Have I brought anyone to Christ?

PRAYING: Lord Jesus, give me the courage to obey your word and trust you when I am in "deep water."

Too often we think we are insignificant and God wouldn't want us to be spokes person. We thinks that there are others who are more worthy. We don't give ourselves the due credit.

The prophet Isaiah heard God's call a he offered sacrifice at the altar. Isaiah felt unworthy to speak God's word. But if Isaiah did not respond, whom would God send? Purged of his sins, Isaiah declared, "Here I am, send me."

The Apostle Paul experienced God's call when he went to Damascus to persecute the Christians in the city. Paul felt that he was the least among the apostles. Yet he learned to accept God's trust in him. By God's grace, Paul boldly brought the gospel to the then known world.

Peter heard God's call while Jesus was preaching . Like Isaiah and Paul, Peter recognized his own sinful nature and even asked Jesus to leave him. Instead, Jesus asked Peter to push out into deeper waters. Because Peter obeyed Jesus' words, he caught a great amount of fish, which really was a sign of his future mission.

What about us? Flawed and sinful we may be, we are called to cast out nets and draw others to the Lord. The future of Holy Family lies with what we do today. If we neglect our mission and evangelism calling, the future will look bleak. Sometimes we do not answer God's call because we are afraid to fail. May we always keep these words of Jesus, "Be not afraid." Our guidance will be directed by the Holy Spirit, Who will guide and teach us all that we will be required.
