

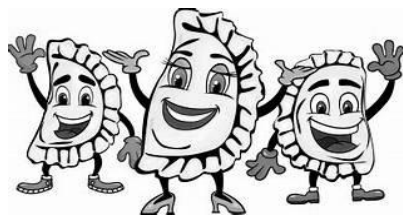

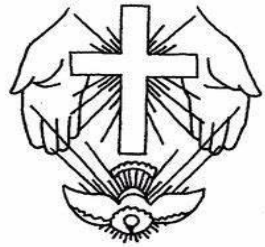
TRINITY SUNDAY

First Reading: Proverbs 8: 22-31

Responsorial: 8

Second Reading: Romans 5: 1-5

Gospel: John 16: 12-15



KEY VERSES: "Everything the Father has is mine: all the Spirit tells you will be taken from what is mine." John 16: 15

READINGS: The first reading has a long praise of wisdom. Wisdom is knowledge of what is essential in human life. The second reading relates that the Holy Trinity is at work. Jesus has made our peace with His Father. With the Father and Son within us, the gifts of the Holy Spirit make us spiritually rich. In Jesus' last discourse, He promises the disciples the gifts of the Holy Spirit. This gift will involve the disciples in the innermost life of God, and the enlightenment given by the Spirit to enable them to preach it to all the earth.

REFLECTING: This Sunday is all about the "Divine Community" - in other words, the way in which our God is in himself a communion of love: Father, Son and Spirit, distinct yet perfectly united - three persons, one God. We hear of the perfect union between Father and Son, revealed in the mysterious poem of the First Reading, where the Son is "Wisdom" joining the Father in the act of creation. This union bears fruit in the Spirit, who pours this perfect love into our hearts, so that we may imitate the "Communion of Love" by living together and hoping for our place within the Divine Community.

PRAYING: Heavenly Father, You gave us the Holy Spirit to help us bring Jesus' love and redemption to the world. Give us the wisdom and knowledge of the Spirit's gifts so that as disciples of Jesus, we can lead all people towards salvation. This we pray through Jesus Christ our Lord.
